The Board of County Commissioners met at 10:30 A. M. pursuant to adjournment as Board of Equalization. Chairman Luke, Commissioner Monk and Clerk Shaw were present.

A load limit of 300 lbs. per inch width of tire was ordered placed on the following road: From the junction of Denver Street and Wisconsin Avenue to the junction of Edgewood Place and Wisconsin Avenue and from the junction of Colorado Avenue and Denver Street to the junction of Colorado Avenue and Edgewood Place. A load limit was placed on the red bridge South of Columbia Falls crossing the Flathead River of not more than ten head of loose stock crossing the bridge at a time and traveling not faster than a walk.

The balance of the day was spent in taking up routine matters.

The Board of County Commissioners met at 10:00 A. M. pursuant to adjournment. Chairman Luke, Commissioners Carr and Monk and Clerk Shaw were present.

Motion was made by Commissioner Monk, seconded by Commissioner Carr that the following resolution be adopted:

The Board of County Commissioners having had presented to it petitions for the creation of a fire district to be known as the "Evergreen Fire District" and embracing the area known as School District No. 50 according to a map or plat thereof on file in the office of the County Superintendent of Schools, hereby determines that said petitions have been signed by owners of more than 50% of the area included within the proposed district and that said signers constitute a majority of the taxpayers who are freeholders of such territory or village, whose names appear upon the last completed assessment roll.

Motion carried unanimously; therefore Evergreen Fire District is hereby established and created. Carl Lasater, Robert Sykes, Harry Andrews, Harold Mohn and Martin Sundberg are hereby appointed Trustees of the Evergreen Fire District.

Check in the sum of \$65.00 was received from the U. S. Treasurer as refund on burial of George Otto Hartl. Same ordered credited to the Poor Fund.

Agreement was signed with R. F. Merritt for repair of County Building roofs at contract price of \$250.00.
